

“If you call a tail a leg, how many legs has a dog? Five? No, calling a tail a leg doesn’t make it a leg.” *Abraham Lincoln*

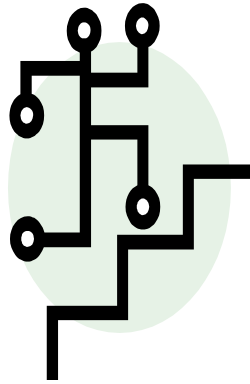

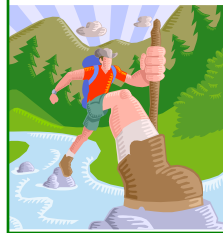

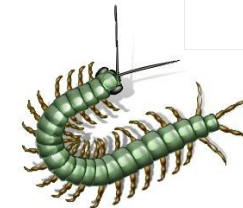

We would like to welcome you to Art & Science Camp 2011! We are trying to get a leg up and get you the camp details early. This is going to be our 12th year at Camp Latgawa. We are excited to have your child join our camping program this summer. Central Point Parks and Recreation is pleased to partner with other organizations to make the camp possible.

The goal of Art & Science Camp is to provide youth with opportunities for hands-on learning in a natural setting. We are able to accomplish this goal by challenging them with new experiences in art, science and their natural environment found at the camp. Learning is accomplished in a non-traditional setting which encourages free expression and expansion of horizons. Kids interact with staff and their peers during meals, recreation and learning environments. Learning is done with the simplest of tasks, even setting the table and cleaning up the dishes. Everyone pitches in and helps keep the camp clean.

TUITION:

A \$100 NON-REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT is due at the time of registration for ALL campers wishing to attend. Deposit is applied toward camp cost and ensures that your child has a place reserved. The balance of the camp fee must be paid by July 15th.
